

Bird Walk 1½-2hrs

Join a naturalist-birder. Easy stroll. Meet at the Mono Lake County Park 5 miles north of Lee Vining just east of Hwy 395.

Stars Over Mono Lake 1½hrs (NPS)

June 25th - July 30th
Starts at 8:30pm
August 6th - August 27th
Starts at 8:00pm
September 3rd - 17th
Starts at 7:30pm
Explore the skies over Mono Lake. Meet at South Tufa Kiosk. Bring something to sit on & dress warmly.

South Tufa Walk 1-1½hrs

Discover the mystery of Mono Lake's strange waters, geology & wildlife. Meet at South Tufa Kiosk 5 miles east of Hwy 395 on Hwy 120 east.

Panum Crater Walk 1½hrs

Discover the geologic history of the Mono Basin with a walk around Panum Crater. Meet at the Panum Crater parking lot 5 miles south of Lee Vining on Hwy 395, 3 miles east on Hwy 120, look for tour signs.

Lundy Canyon Bird Walk 2hrs

Join a naturalist for a leisurely walk up Lundy Canyon, where the convergence of coniferous forest, sage scrub, riparian woodlands, and open water offers a diverse list of bird species." Meet in front of the Lundy Lake Resort.

Lundy Canyon Walk 1½-2hrs

Discover the cultural and natural history of the beautiful Lundy Canyon. Meet at Historical marker at Lundy Resort 7 miles north of Lee Vining on Hwy 395, turn left on Lundy Lake Rd.
